Mission Statement:

Purpose: The Marr Sunday School Intern works directly with children by teaching Christian values from the Bible with stories and through music, play, and art experiences in a safe, welcoming, child-centered environment, while also gaining career experiences in lesson planning and instruction.

Essential Functions:

- Instruct weekly Sunday school lesson plans for Elementary-aged children
- Instruct weekly Little Ones lesson plans for PreK children
- Create lessons for Little Ones and Elementary-aged Sunday school classes with guidance from the Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministries.
- Support Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministries with Community Events and outreach to families.

Administrative Responsibilities

- Provide a clean, safe, and welcoming environment for Sunday School students
- Ensure classroom(s) are set-up with materials needed each week
- Maintain classroom supplies

Reports To:

The Marr Sunday School Intern will report to, and will be directly accountable to, the Pastor, with oversight by the Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministries, and the Staff Parish Relations Committee at Sand Point Community United Methodist Church.

Compensation:

This internship is a part-time paid salary position and requires 3-5 hours per week with at least 2 hours occurring on Sunday mornings. Compensation is \$335 a month. Internship is available for a 9-month period spanning from September-June.
